#### Abortion on Demand

**John Sununu** opposes abortion and supports protection for unborn children.

**Jeanne Shaheen** supports the current policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

#### Partial-Birth Abortion

*The partial-birth abortion procedure – used from the fifth month on – involves pulling a living baby feet-first out of the womb, except for the head, puncturing the skull and suctioning out the brain. The great majority of partial-birth abortions are performed on healthy babies of healthy mothers.*

**John Sununu** voted to ban partial-birth abortion.

**Jeanne Shaheen** is against bills to ban partial-birth abortion. As governor she formally commended a New Hampshire pro-abortion leader for defeating bills to ban partial-birth abortion.

#### Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

**John Sununu** opposes using your tax dollars to pay for abortion.

**Jeanne Shaheen** supports using your tax dollars to pay for abortion.

#### Parental Notification

**John Sununu** voted for a bill that would prevent minor daughters from being taken across state lines for secret abortions without parental notice or consent.

**Jeanne Shaheen**, as a New Hampshire state senator, voted against requiring parental notice before an abortion is performed on a minor daughter.
